The Russia-Pakistan Eurasian Forum 2025, jointly organized by the Zhirinovsky University of World Civilizations (Moscow), the Federal Urdu University of Arts, Science & Technology (FUUAST), Islamabad, and the Consortium for Asia-Pacific and Eurasian Studies (CAPES), is a premier academic and policy platform dedicated to advancing cooperation between Pakistan and Russia within the broader Eurasian landscape.

Held on 16-17 December 2025 in Moscow, the Forum brings together scholars, policymakers, diplomats, business leaders, media professionals, and youth representatives to discuss shared opportunities and challenges shaping regional and global dynamics. FORUM CONCEPT

The conference aims to bring together policymakers, business leaders, academia, and cultural experts to discuss and explore opportunities for enhancing economic connectivity and people-to-people contact between Pakistan and Russia. 


H.E. Faisal Niaz Tirmazi


Dr. Maria Sultan
